



New Arizona License Structure and Fees

General Fishing	Allows take of all fish species statewide, including at <i>Community Fishing</i> waters. (Valid for one year from date of purchase)	\$37	\$55
General Hunting	Allows take of small game, fur-bearing animals, predatory animals, certain nongame animals and upland game birds. A valid tag or stamp is required for the take of big game animals and migratory game birds. (Valid for one year from date of purchase)	\$37	Not available - see Combination below.
Combination Hunt and Fish	Allows take of all fish species statewide (including at <i>Community Fishing</i> waters), small game, fur-bearing animals, predatory animals, certain nongame animals and upland game birds. A valid tag or stamp is required for the take of big game animals and migratory game birds. (Valid for one year from date of purchase)	\$57	\$160
Youth Combination Hunt and Fish (ages 10-17)	Allows take of all fish species statewide (including at <i>Community Fishing</i> waters), small game, fur-bearing animals, predatory animals, certain nongame animals, and migratory and upland game birds. A valid tag is required for the take of big game animals. (Valid for one year from date of purchase)	\$5	\$5
Short-Term Combination Hunt and Fish	Allows take of all fish species statewide (including at <i>Community Fishing</i> waters), small game, fur-bearing animals, predatory animals, certain nongame animals and upland game birds. A valid stamp is required for the take of migratory game birds.	\$15/day	\$20/day
Community Fishing	Allows take of all fish species in <i>Community Fishing</i> waters (Valid for one year from date of purchase)	\$24	\$24
Migratory Bird Stamp	Allows take of band-tailed pigeons, moorhen, coots, doves, ducks, geese, snipe and swans (Valid July 1-June 30). Stamp is included with Youth Combo Hunt/Fish license.	\$5	\$5

- Notes:
- All licenses that allow fishing allow for the take of trout and for simultaneous fishing w/ 2 poles.
 - Individuals 18 years and older who hunt migratory birds must purchase a Migratory Bird Stamp.
 - Individuals 16 years and older who hunt waterfowl must also, under federal law, purchase a federal waterfowl stamp.
 - Short-Term Combo Hunt/Fish license may be purchased for any day. If purchased for multiple days, the days need not be consecutive.
