**DIRECTOR'S ORDER 1 – AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES
INITIAL LISTING OF AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES FOR ARIZONA
EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2010**

Effective March 1, 2010 the Arizona Game and Fish Department, under the authority of A.R.S. 17-255.01(B), establishes this initial list of aquatic invasive species for the State of Arizona:

Aquatic Invasive Species	Notes
quagga mussel <i>(Dreissena bugensis)</i>	Detected in Arizona in January of 2007.
zebra mussel <i>(Dreissena polymorpha)</i>	Not yet detected in Arizona, but poses an immediate threat. Zebra mussels are nearly indistinguishable in appearance from the quagga mussel.
