# AZGFD 2011 Calendar Photo Contest Rules

## Changes to This Year's Contest:

- 1. You are not required to submit 8x10 inch prints with your submission. Simply send us a CD or DVD with your three high-resolution entries.**
- 2. Transparencies will not be accepted.**

## Eligibility

The contest is open to any photographer except employees of the Arizona Game and Fish Department and members of their immediate families (parents, spouses, children, or siblings living in the same household).

## Theme

Send us your best, most magnificent wildlife photos.

All animal photos must be of wildlife found in Arizona and all photos must be taken in Arizona. Photos of pets, livestock or insects (including butterflies or dragonflies) are not eligible.

## Format for Submissions

**Digital images:** Digital images on disk. Images must be: HORIZONTAL, 300 dpi, jpeg or tiff, 8 bit and at least 9x12 inches. To capture the required high-resolution image, set your camera at the highest level of quality possible; on some cameras, this setting is called "super fine." Read the owner's manual for instructions. This setting will create big files (meaning fewer pictures will fit on each memory card). Digital pictures taken with a 6-megapixel camera or larger are preferred. Manipulation of digital images must be limited to the kinds of manipulation that can be done with traditional film printing techniques, such as burning in and dodging, eliminating dust spots, etc. Images in which content has been altered will not be accepted.

**Images less than 300 dpi and 9x12 inches will be disqualified.**

## Entry Procedure

1. Each contestant may submit 3 entries per person.
2. Each entry must be identified with the owner's full name and address typed or printed clearly on each disk.
3. Send an entry form with your submission, with the following information (or use the entry form provided):
  - Name of photographer
  - Mailing address (good through December 2010)
  - Telephone number (good through December 2010)
  - E-mail address
  - Subject/location
  - Where and when taken
  - Camera model (optional)
  - Exposure mode, ISO, f/stop (optional)
4. Do not include other materials with your submission (for example, subscription orders, draw applications, checks, correspondence or the like).
5. Receipt of entries will not be acknowledged unless a self-addressed, stamped postcard is included.
6. Incomplete submissions will be disqualified.

## Return of Entries

No materials will be returned.

## Prizes

Twelve first-place, plus one "Best in Show" (for the cover photo) awards will be given. All winners will receive calendars, certificates of achievement and a small cash prize. Winning names will be posted on [www.azgfd.gov/photocontest](http://www.azgfd.gov/photocontest).

## Judging

Entries will be judged on the basis of creativity, photographic quality, and effectiveness in conveying the unique character of the subject. The judges' decisions are final.

## Deadline
