H2230: Now: WATERCRAFT VIOLATIONS 4/4 - Language struck onto S1248.

S1247: WATERCRAFT; REGISTRATION RENEWAL 4/16 - Signed by Governor (Chap. 119)

S1248: WATERCRAFT ACCIDENTS; REPORTING 4/25 - Signed by Governor (Chap. 245)

S1250: SHOOTING RANGES 4/21 - Signed by Governor (Chap. 177)

S1524: HUNTING CONTESTS 1/31 – Not pursued by Sponsor.

S1575: WATERCRAFT OPERATOR LICENSE 3/20 - Dead.

H2212: FEDERAL MONIES; APPROPRIATION 3/13 – Failed.

SIGNED BILLS THAT IMPACT THE DEPARTMENT

H2337: STATE CREDIT CARD PAYMENT FEES: State agencies that contract with private companies to process credit-card payments for agency charges **may** allow these agents to charge convenience fees to the cardholders. An agency doing 30% or more of its transactions electronically must report cost benefits to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee.

1107: RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE SUBSIDIES (Chapter 376): Authorizes until June 30, 2003 a temporary health and accident insurance premium payment increase for nonservice area retired members of the Arizona State Retirement System (ASRS), Public Safety Personnel Retirement System (PSPRS), and Corrections Officers Retirement Plan (CORP).

H2582: STATE PROCUREMENT; ON-LINE BIDDING (Chapter 375): State procurement officers are authorized to take on-line bids from suppliers of goods, services, construction and information services.

H2043: STATE WEB SITE PRIVACY (Chapter 269): State agency web sites must carry statements on the agencies' policies on information-gathering and dissemination and what protection is offered a person's information if the person transacts business with the agency on the internet.
