Tuesday, August 31, 2010, 9:30 a.m. at the Rosemont Activities Center, 12700 E. Greaterville Road, Sonoita, Arizona 85637.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public that a quorum of the Arizona Game and Fish Commission may attend and participate in a tour of the Rosemont Mine Project site on August 31, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. Directions to the site are as follows:

Take Exit 281 off of Interstate 10 (Arizona State Route 83) and head south approximately 17 miles. Just prior to Mile Marker 41, turn west onto the Greaterville Road. Proceed for almost ½ mile, stay right as the road forks, continue driving for approximately two miles. On the left side of the road you will see the Rosemont Copper Activities Center. There is a large silver mailbox marked with "12700" at the location.

All attendees are encouraged to wear appropriate outdoor gear, including long pants, closed toe shoes, a hat and sun-screen. Water will be provided for attendees. There will be numerous stops where participants will be out of the vehicle on uneven ground etc. Additionally, any public attendees will be allowed to drive their personal vehicles; however there may be a need for off-road vehicle capability as the roads are unimproved dirt roads.

The purpose of the trip is for Rosemont Copper representatives to provide information regarding the proposed Rosemont Mine project to members of the Commission. The Commission will not discuss or deliberate on any matter reasonably anticipated to come before the Commission for legal action.


Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public that a quorum of the Arizona Game and Fish Commission may attend and listen to members of the public express their views regarding the Rosemont Mine project. The Commission will not take any legal action at this meeting.

Background materials provided to Commission members concerning the tour are available for public inspection at the main office of the Arizona Game and Fish Department at 5000 W. Carefree Highway, Phoenix AZ, 85086, and at Department regional offices in Pinetop, Flagstaff, Kingman, Yuma, Tucson, and Mesa.

In addition, the Department is charged with promoting safe and responsible use of watercraft and off-highway vehicles. Funding is provided from the sale of licenses and permits; watercraft registration fees; federal excise taxes on firearms, fishing equipment, boats, and other sporting goods; State lottery revenues; donations on State income tax forms; and various contracts and grants. Department policy is set by the Arizona Game and Fish Commission, whose five members are appointed by the Governor.
