

| The citizens of this State have a right to lawfully hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife. Wildlife belongs to the State and is held in trust for the benefit of the citizens. Exclusive authority to enact laws to regulate the manner, methods or seasons for hunting, fishing, and harvesting wildlife shall be vested in the Legislature, which shall delegate rulemaking authority to a commission. No law shall be enacted, and no rule shall be adopted, that unreasonably restricts hunting, fishing and harvesting wildlife or the use of traditional means and methods. Laws and rules authorized hereunder shall have the purpose of wildlife conservation and management and preserving the future of hunting and fishing.

| Lawful public hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of managing and controlling wildlife. Nothing herein shall be construed to modify any provision of common law or statutes relating to trespass or property rights.
