

**SPECIAL NOTICE OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING OF
 THE ARIZONA GAME AND FISH COMMISSION HELD ON OCTOBER 1, 2013**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(D), notice is hereby given that an emergency meeting of the Arizona Game and Fish Commission was held on October 1, 2013, at 4:00 p.m. at the Arizona Game and Fish Department Headquarters, 5000 W. Carefree Highway, Phoenix, Arizona 85086.

The meeting was convened under emergency circumstances to discuss and consider maintaining hunting and fishing access to federal lands/facilities that were closed the morning of October 1, 2013 as part of the government shut-down. The Commission was briefed and provided guidance to the Department on approaching federal agencies about using Department resources to maintain hunting and fishing access to now-closed federal lands/facilities, including Lee's Ferry.

Commissioners Present: Vice Chairman Mansell, Commissioner Davis, Commissioner Madden

This meeting was facilitated by Gary Hovatter, Special Assistant to the Director

Commission action taken:

Motion: Davis moved and Madden seconded that the Commission direct the Department to offer the National Park Service manpower and services for the purpose of maintaining security on federal property and to federal assets at Lees Ferry for up to 30 days in exchange for allowing access through Lees Ferry to the Colorado River for fishing and hunting activities in accordance with state game and fish regulations during the federal government shutdown. For the purposes of this motion access means the ability to fish or take waterfowl from shore or boat on the Colorado River from the confluence of the Paria River upstream to Glen Canyon Dam. The Department will monitor costs and report to the Commission should those costs become of concern.
