
RMEF RED MOUNTAIN CHAPTER 2013 WORK PROJECT

Saturday morning we will meet at this location and plan to leave by 6:30 am to meet with Jim O'Haco (Chevelon Butte Cattle Company owner) at the loading chutes east of Chevelon Butte on Forest Road 34 at 7:00 am.

We will be repairing damaged fence and installing elk jumps. Please bring leather gloves, long-sleeve shirts, fence pliers and plenty of water.
