#### Eligibility:

SCTP Fun Shoots are open to all individuals registered in the Arizona Game and Fish Department Scholastic Clay Target Program.

#### Coaching:

As a courtesy to the other coaches in the SCTP Program, coaching will be permitted **ONLY** to your own club members and will be allowed **ONLY** by a certified **SCTP Coach**. Any coaching may not interfere with the flow of the match.

#### Spectators:

All spectators need to be courteous of all shooters and SCTP coaches. Please be quiet while the contestants are shooting. **NO** yelling or “coaching” will be allowed. If you choose to ignore warnings given from a SCTP Coach, your child will be disqualified. Applause and light cheering is allowed and encouraged!

#### Rules:

National ATA, NSSA, and NSCA rules will apply. All rules stated in this fun shoot information bulletin will supersede any state or national rule.

#### Targets:

Regulation targets are those set by the local trap and skeet club. The host club has the right to substitute targets as needed to complete the contest.

#### Entry Fees:

For Level 1 shooters a \$8.00 entry fee per discipline per competitor will be charged, \$20.00 for all three events combined. For Level 2 and 3 shooters a \$14.00 entry fee per discipline per competitor will be charged, \$40 for all three events combined.

Disciplines include; Trap, Skeet and 5-Stand or Sporting Clays. Only 3 of the 4 disciplines listed will be provided for the shoots. Lunch and ammunition are **NOT** included in the entry fee.

**NEW:** *Level 1 shooters course of fire will be 25 targets for each discipline. Level 2 and 3 shooters course of fire will be 50 targets for each discipline.*

#### Entries:

Advance registration is required. Registrations received after closing date will **NOT** be accepted. No refunds will be given.

If necessary the Lead Instructor may make alternate arrangements to submit registration paperwork and monies.

**Classifications:**

Level 1 (Average 0-9 Targets broken in any discipline)  
Level 2 (Average 10-18 Targets broken in any discipline)  
Level 3 (Average 19-25 Targets broken in any discipline)

All entries and classifications of the participants will be at the discretion of the Lead Instructor(s) for each individual club.

**Note: A participant will be classed in all events entered according to their highest classification in any one discipline.**

**Course of Fire:**

*Level I shooters course of fire will be 25 targets for each discipline. Level II and III shooters course of fire will be 50 targets for each discipline.*

**Trap:** Follow ATA rules and procedures.

**Skeet:** Follow NSSA rules and procedures. With the exception of Level 1 which will receive report pairs as opposed to true pairs.

**Sporting Clays:** Sporting Clays will be shot on an approved Sporting Clays course. The course of fire for a fun shoot will be a combined total of 25 shots on a Sporting Clays Course for Level I and 50 targets for Level II and III. Participants will shoot a course of fire that could include: Singles, Report Pairs or True Pairs. With the exception of Level 1 which will receive report pairs as opposed to true pairs.
