**-WHERE-**

**BASE CAMP @ RUDD KNOLL in UNIT 1  
SOUTH OF SPRINGERVILLE ON HWY 261**

**-DESCRIPTION-**

We will be removing unneeded old barbed wire fencing, repairing fencing around riparian areas, reconstruction of fence and trick tank water repairs in cooperation with the USFS and the 26 Bar Ranch.

**-TOOLS-**

Please bring fence pliers, wire side cutters, small bolt cutter and gloves if you have them. Some items will be provided. Please make sure to bring appropriate hats, long sleeve shirts, sunblock etc. Be prepared for cool mornings and possibly rain. Old clothes are recommended for those working with the barbed wire fences.

**-CAMPING-**

The Camp site is on the north side of Rudd Knoll 6 miles NE of the junction of Highway 273 and 261 (Crescent Lake) on the east side of Highway 261. From the west take Highway 260 east from Pinetop-Lake side to the Highway 273 turnoff to Sunrise lake. Proceed southeast on highway 273 about 20+ miles to the Junction with Highway 261 at Crescent Lake. Head NE 6 miles on Highway 261 to Rudd Knoll on the east side of the road. From Eagar-Springerville area head west on Highway 260 3+ miles to Highway 261 south. Go 15+ miles to Rudd Knoll. Look for Arizona Elk Society signs. Space will be available for vehicle, tent and RV camping. Porta-Johns and wash stations will be available in camp.

**-MEALS-**

We will be providing meals Friday night, Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner, and Sunday breakfast and some lunch on Sunday. Water and refreshments will be available in camp.

We are a family oriented organization; however projects are potentially dangerous working with barbed wire, power tools and vehicles.  
Kids under 18 need to be supervised by an adult.
