

Arizona Game and Fish Department's Beginners' Dove Hunt

The Seminar and field day are open to the public free of charge but will be limited to the first 30 participants to sign up.

The Zimmerman dairy is just north of Queen Creek.

The orientation seminar will be held on September 10th at 7 p.m. at the Arizona Game and Fish Department's Mesa Regional Office, 7200 E. University in Mesa.

The Mesa Regional Office is located approximately ¼ mile east of the intersection of Power rd. and University dr. in Mesa.

The field day will be held on September 12th meeting at 5 a.m. at the Northeast corner of E. Germann Rd. and S. Meridian Dr. north of Queen Creek.

Direction to the dove hunting area from US 60 and Ellsworth rd. are:

Go 7.5 mile south on Ellsworth rd toward Queen Creek to Germann rd. Then turn left or East on Germann and go 3 miles to the entrance of the Dairy at the intersection of Germann rd. and Meridian dr.

The Arizona Game and Fish Department will supply the first box of ammunition (12, 20, 410 gage) to participants and has 20 shotguns available as loaners to hunters.

Jr. Hunters under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Hot coffee and cold water will be supplied to participants. Participants will need to purchase an Arizona State Hunting License and a HIP (Harvest Information Program) stamp to participate. License and stamp are available at all Arizona Game and Fish Department Offices and through most sporting good stores.
