The Arizona Game and Fish Department is offering free weekend workshops on small game hunting in Arizona, sponsored by American Fire Equipment and the Chandler Rod and Gun Club.

Get experience pursuing and field dressing squirrel (at Vincent Ranch) or dove, quail and rabbit (at Robbins Butte). Study the secrets of small-game behavior. Learn to choose the right clothing and ammunition. Practice setting up a comfortable hunting camp. Find out how to gain and maintain permission to hunt on privately owned land and hunt safely.

All participants receive a free hunting license, courtesy of American Fire Equipment. The following will be provided:

- Meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- Water, coffee and hot chocolate
- Marshmallow roast
- Firearms and ammunition (no alcohol, no exceptions)



Space is limited to 40 people per workshop. Participants must be at least 10 years of age to attend. The workshop is free, but pre-registration and a refundable deposit of \$20 per person are required to ensure that spaces aren't reserved and then not used.
