The Old Way

- For the past few years, the listing of HAHWG events have been manually collated in a list format on the G&F website: www.azgfd.gov/outdoorskills.
- The list has served us well in the early stages, but there are cons to this method:
 - Single category: unable to overlay b2b activities
 - Chronological list: allows limited details, long page
 - Manual updating of expired events
 - Restricted access behind AZGFD administration
 - Doesn't allow integrated use by partners on their sites


