



Department Loaner Equipment Kits:

Department equipment kits are available for check-out for events, game camps and other activities that support the mission of the Arizona Game and Fish Department.

All equipment kits are required to have email requests sent to the program coordinator a **minimum of two weeks prior** to the date of pick up. A confirmation email will be sent verifying the reservation and date and time of pickup. Equipment pick up will be through a Department office location.

For all **firearms** equipment, the instructor (individual responsible for the equipment and safety of the program during the event) must be a certified AZGFD staff, volunteer or NRA instructor. If the responsible person/instructor is not an AZGFD staff or instructor, a copy of the instructor's certification and FFL is required.

For all **archery** equipment, the instructor (individual responsible for the equipment and safety of the program during the event) must be a certified AZGFD staff, volunteer or submit a copy of a recognized archery instructor certification which includes an Intermediate Instructor (Level 2) instructor certificate by USA Archery or NFAA.

Binocular kit:

- Kits include tripods, tripod adapters and binoculars
- Three kits available

GPS Kit:

- Includes 5 Garmin GPS 12 units
- One kit available

Archery Kits:

- Includes 10 bows, 5 dozen arrows and 5 targets
- Approximately 8 kits available

.22 Rifle Kits:

- Includes seven Savage Mark 1G and three Savage Cub .22's or ten Marlin .22 rifles
- Three kits available

Air-Rifle Kits:

- Includes 5 Daisy Legend 853 or 5 Crossman Raven air-rifles, 5 pellet traps, pellets, eye protection and paper target faces
- Approximately 8 kits available

Inflatable BB gun range

- Self standing inflatable bb gun range, bb guns and targets (power required)
- One unit available

Handgun Kits:

- Includes 5 Ruger .22 pistols
- 3 kits available

Shotguns:

- 12 gauge, 20 gauge and 20 gauge youth model semi-automatics.

Cook trailer:

- Fully stocked utility trailer outfitted for cooking at outdoor events and activities.

Bone Boxes:

- These environmental education kits are loaded with wildlife parts from skulls, furs, footprints, and more. They also have lesson plans that are adaptable for all ages.

Fishing Poles:

- Fishing pole kits for basic fishing events are available through the Sport Fishing Education.

Backyard Bass Casting Game:

- A casting game that is perfect for younger audiences in nearly any environment, also available from the Sport Fishing Education program.
