Shooting enthusiasts can purchase ammunition for a nominal fee and test the latest firearms from several manufacturers on our firing range. Our line safety officers will provide assistance and ensure a safe, enjoyable experience.

Shooting demonstrations

Shooting demonstrations will be held twice daily on our shooting range. These may include sharpshooting, quick-draw, clay targets and archery.

Throughout the showcase, workshops and demonstrations will entertain and inform everyone, from people who have never tried hunting or shooting to experienced hunters to families interested in introducing their children to outdoor recreation.


