

Dear Public Lands Visitor:



The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Yuma Field Office is in the preliminary stages of developing the La Posa Travel Management Plan and Environmental Assessment. The La Posa Travel Management Area surrounds Quartzsite, Arizona, and encompasses over 380,000 acres of BLM land in La Paz and Yuma Counties. The primary goal of the travel management plan is to officially designate all 1,700 miles of inventoried roads, trails, drivable desert washes, and other linear features as open, closed, or limited to public use.

The BLM Yuma Field Office will hold the following informational Open Houses to explain how individuals can participate in the travel management planning process:

- **January 15, 2008 – 6 to 8 p.m.** – BLM Yuma Field Office, 2555 E. Gila Ridge Road, Yuma, AZ
- **January 17, 2008 – 4 to 6 p.m.** – Quartzsite Senior Center, 40 S. Moon Mountain Avenue, Quartzsite, AZ
- **January 23, 2008 – 6 to 8 p.m.** Pacific time (7 to 9 p.m. Mountain time) - Blythe Community Center, 445 N. Broadway, Blythe, CA
