Grant Application Form Instructions:

4. LIP funds can only be expended on privately deeded property.
5. Provide the number of contiguous private acres surrounding the project site.
6. Provide the acreage that will be improved by the project (i.e. the size of the area to benefit from the project).
7. Provide a general description of the vegetation/habitat, such as pinyon/juniper, grassland, ponderosa pine.
8. Please describe the river, creek, drainage, or wetland (name, vegetation, etc.) and where it is located on the private property.
9. Describe the funding for the entire project, including any in-kind or cash contribution from the landowner and/or any 3rd party monetary contribution (i.e. other project funds from NRCS, AGFD, etc.).
