## SHOOTING, ARCHERY, COMPETITIONS AND CAMPING

The 1,650-acre Ben Avery Shooting Facility has a covered public main range with 53 shooting stations and 16 other rifle and pistol ranges. There are seven field archery ranges and a FITA range, and the Clay Target Center has trap, skeet, sporting clays and five stand courses. Targets and ear and eye protection can be purchased at the main range and spotting scopes can be rented.

Rifle and pistol ranges may be reserved by competitive shooting clubs and buildings may be reserved for classes and events.

The shooter's campground has 55 sites with water and electric service up to 50 amps (\$25 a day) and 45 sites without utilities (\$10 a day). There are three restrooms with showers and a dump station that is free to guests.

## JOIN A CLUB

Many clubs offer firearms training, instruction and competition. Rifle, pistol, shotgun and archery events are held regularly. Many shooting clubs also offer classes.

## VOLUNTEER

Volunteers serve as line safety officers, teach new shooters and help maintain the facility. Volunteers shoot for free.

## LEARN TO SHOOT

Kids can learn about the shotgun sports in the Arizona Game and Fish Department's Scholastic Clay Target Program. Teams compete during the school year and each season culminates in statewide competitions. Call (602) 942-3000.

The Ben Avery 4-H Club shoots under lights at the small bore range at 6 p.m. every Thursday in winter. Parents serve as coaches and safety officers. Firearms, ammunition and targets are provided. Call (602) 470-8086, ext. 352.

The Annie Oakley Sure Shots help women learn to shoot or to improve their skills. The group meets at the main range at 7 p.m. every Thursday. Instruction, firearms, ammunition, eye and ear protection are provided. Call (623) 582-8313.
