

Reppy Water Development

The Reppy allotment falls within the southern end of the Dragoon Mountains on the Douglas Ranger District of the Coronado National Forest. There are currently few reliable water sources in the area. The proposed action involves running pipelines from the base of the Reppy and the Bennett dams each to 5,000 gallon storages and troughs. With these two systems in place, approximately 2,500 acres of rangeland and wildlife habitat will be watered within one mile of the new improvements.
