A. Welcome, Introductions, Ground Rules, and Agenda Review

B. Overview of the Processes for Considering Public Comment on the 5-Year Review of the Mexican Wolf Blue Range Reintroduction Project, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the Project, and a Proposed Moratorium in 2006 on New Releases of Mexican Wolves
